



ORDER SETTING MIDLAND COUNTY, TEXAS, TAX RATE FOR 2023

Whereas, it is necessary for the Midland County Commissioner's Court to levy a tax for 2023 in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Midland County residents: therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT:

1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be assessed and collected for 2023 an ad valorem tax of \$.120430 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the County as shown on the final approved 2023 tax roll of the County.


This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:

Maintenance and Operating Expense Tax Rate	\$.00118298
Debt Service Tax Rate	\$.00002132
2023 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	\$.00120430


2. That said tax rate has been set in due regard for the budget requirements of Midland County government use for 2023.


