

Our Family Wizard Language

The Court finds that it is in the best interest of the child(ren) for the parties to communicate regarding the child(ren) through OurFamily Wizard (hereinafter referred to as "OFW"). The parties are ordered to establish an OFW Parent Account. Each party shall enroll in the program by 5:00 p.m. tomorrow. The parties shall enroll by completing the sign-up process at OurFamilyWizard.com or by contacting OFW Customer Support. The parties shall ensure the OFW package enables them to utilize OFW in the manner outlined herein.

After registration, the parties shall immediately begin to utilize their OFW accounts via the website or the mobile applications for iOS or Android. If using the mobile application, the parties shall turn on all push notifications from the mobile application. All communication shall occur exclusively through OFW except in cases of emergency regarding the child that must be acted upon in less than 24 hours. In case of such an emergency, the subject and general content of such communication shall be memorialized in a "Moment" entry in the OFW Journal.

To the extent possible, the parties shall utilize the ToneMeter AI feature for support with writing clear, concise messages. The parties shall not rely exclusively on ToneMeter AI. Any message sent after using ToneMeter AI will be presumed to have been proofread and edited by the party. Parents retain full responsibility for the content of all messages sent.

The parties shall not disseminate any recordings or messages to anyone except their attorneys or other professionals directly involved in this case or as requested by this Court.

The parties shall only utilize the OFW Message Board feature when the information to be communicated cannot be conveyed in the Calendar, Expense Log, Journal, Info Bank, or other OFW features. Whenever an entry requires a response, the receiving parent shall respond within 48 hours unless the entry itself indicates a longer time frame is acceptable.

The parties shall utilize the Check-ins tool in the OFW Journal to memorialize their presence at exchanges.

The parties shall not create records through the OFW application to attempt to communicate with the Court directly.

Unless or until an Order of this Court has been signed ending the parties' utilization of OFW, the parties shall not fail to renew their OFW subscription until the parties' children are no longer subject to the court's jurisdiction.
